In his important study on the trio sonata published in 1992, Peter Allsop has sought after the Italian influences to be found in Purcell's music. Walking in his paths, the Amsterdam violin master Jaap Schröder discovered striking bonds between the «Orpheus Britannicus» and Giovanni Maria Bononcini's sonatas. Author of the famous *Musico prattico* (Bologna, 1673) and father of celebrated Giovanni, Giovanni Maria Bononcini is far too much forgotten nowadays. By this new release, *Fuga Libera* is proud to pay a tribute both to this great composer and his legacy, and to Jaap Schröder, who belongs with Leonhard Bijlsma en Bruggen to the great pioneers of authentic performances in the Netherlands. He is here at his best with a remarkable American ensemble, in a warm and harmonious interplay so necessary for the delicate art of trio sonata. An exceptional meeting between musicology and music, Italy and England, history and spontaneity, and generations of ancient music performers!
